The Australia-Korea Foundation, funded through DFAT, has awarded funding for Professor Bob Dewar and a delegation of Australian plasma physicists to visit Korea to discuss research collaboration on fusion power research, ITER-relevant research and KSTAR. KSTAR is a new facility, now coming on line at the Korean National Fusion Research Institute (NFRI) in Daejeon, that has been built at a cost of > US\$300M.
