Professor Peter Bouwknegt, Department of Theoretical Physics, will be absent from June 5-28. He will attend the workshop on "Geometry, Quantum Fields and Strings: Categorical Aspects" (MFO, Oberwolfach, Germany, June 6-12), which he co-organised, and will be a plenary speaker at the symposium "Physics of Topology" (University of Amsterdam, Netherlands, June 15-16) and the workshop "Geometry and Quantum Field Theory" (MPIM, Bonn, Germany, June 20-26).

Professor Mukunda Das, Department of Theoretical Physics, will visit the Institute of Superconducting and Electronic Materials, University of Wollongong during June 10-12 and will give a seminar.
