The SCU currently maintains a number of general unix/linux workstations and a computational linux cluster accessible by all members of the RSPE community. Scucomp1 and Scucomp2 are the newest general use computational machines for running jobs such as mathematica and matlab calculations, doing compilations and general linux uses. The RSPE cluster has also just been upgraded to a more modern queuing and OS solution. The SCU does not however provide programming support as the RSPE user base has far larger programming expertise throughout departments, although we may be able to point you

in the right direction.
