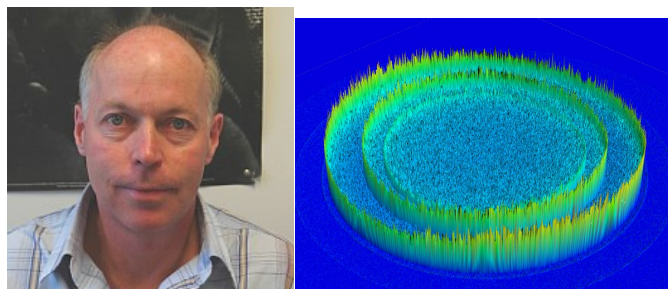
#### Extreme velocity-map imaging of photoelectrons
